The Fraser Valley's history of hop growing is reflected in its diverse craft breweries.

Located less than an hour's drive east of Vancouver, tucked between the Coast and Cascade mountain ranges, the Fraser Valley is a mix of relaxing countryside and rugged backcountry beauty. It's the ideal place to experience authentic farm-fresh experiences, get lost in berry patches and apple orchards, visit a local farmer's market, fill your belly with a farm-to-plate meal, and of course sample a wide variety of delicious, locally brewed craft beers.

With such easy access to agriculture all around them, all of the Fraser Valley breweries love to work closely with farmers to incorporate local produce into their recipes especially hops, one of beer's key ingredients. Indeed, the Valley's long history of hop growing goes back more than a century.

At the same time, four urban centres — Abbotsford, Chilliwack, Langley, and Langley City — offer a diverse range of breweries to visit along with restaurants and other shopping opportunities.

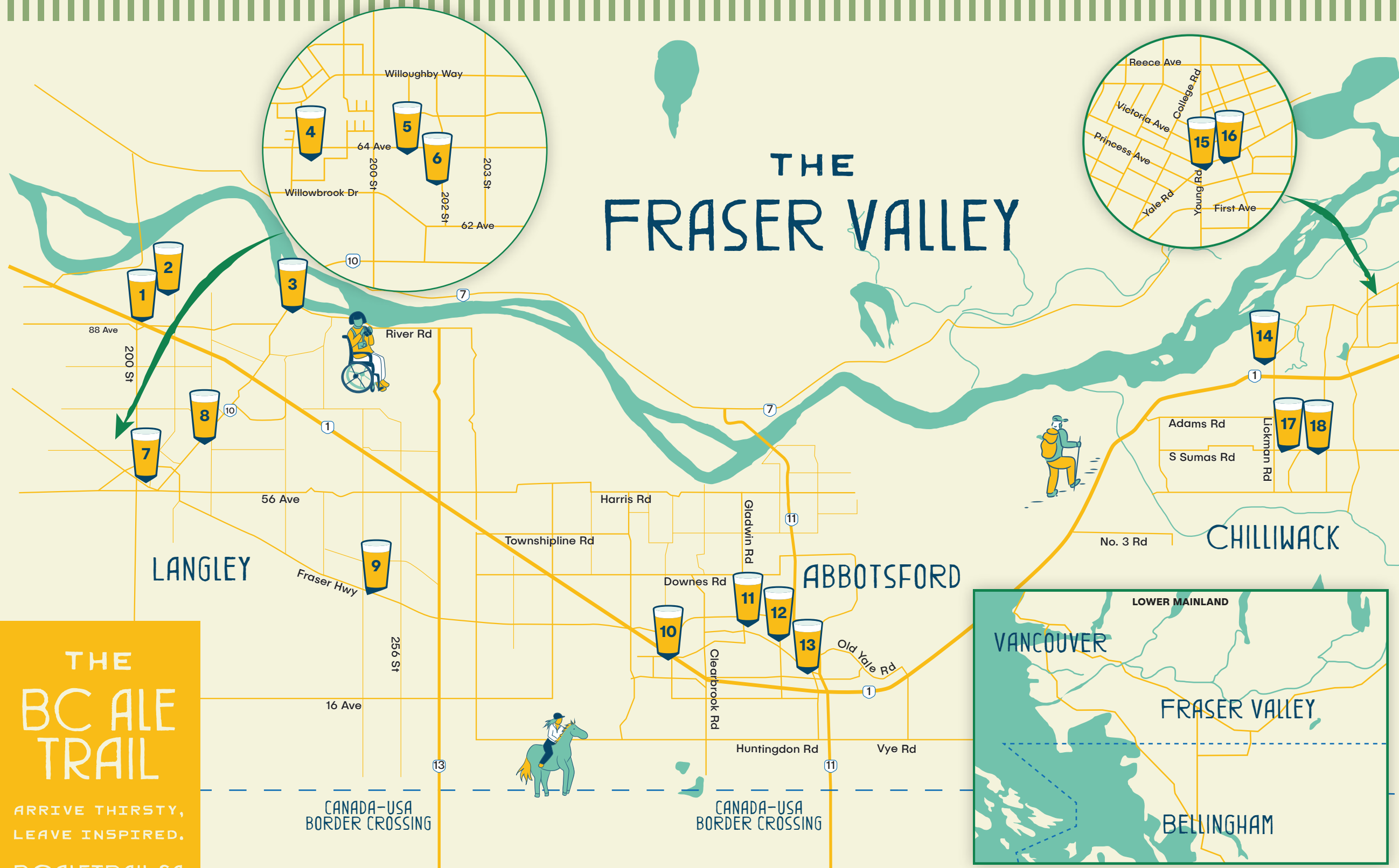
